Job Purpose Statement(s): Under the general direction of the Assistant Superintendent-Educational Support Services this position has the major responsibility for providing library media programs that support the philosophy, goals, and objectives of the school district.

Essential Job Functions:

- Plans and provides ongoing staff development for all school Library Media Specialists.
- Works with building principals and the Assistant Superintendent-Educational Services in assessing needs, facilitating the procurement and availability of audio-visual and library materials needed for current curriculum focus.
- **Provides** recommendations for maintenance and improvement of school library facilities, based on long-range planning, as well as immediacy of need.
- **Participates** actively in county, state and national professional associations and encourages participation by other district media personnel.
- Advises district and school administrators with information regarding computer-based applications
 for library circulation procedures and student access to electronic encyclopedias and/or on-line
 research/reference materials.
- **Manages** the day to day operations of a school library.
